UGOL ROSSII & MINING, NEDRA ROSSII and SAFETY & HEALTH 2019: The trade fair trio on trends and the latest technologies in mining

International companies are expressing great interest in exhibiting +++ More exhibition space +++ Federal German ministry supports official pavilion of the Federal Republic of Germany

The world of mining in one place: The 26th UGOL ROSII & MINING will be held from 4 to 7 June at the exhibition centre in Novokuznetsk, in conjunction with two other trade fairs, NEDRA ROSSII and SAFETY & HEALTH. In 2018 the leading trade fair trio of the Russian coal industry was given top marks, after attracting 630 exhibitors from 27 countries and with 16,000 sqm of exhibition space booked. This year the response from exhibitors was once again positive. The available space was even bigger than at the previous event, as it included an additional exhibition hall.

“We are pleased that there is so much encouragement from exhibitors throughout the world and that so many companies are interested in booking. UGOL ROSII & MINING has long been regarded as the leading trade fair of this sector in Russia. Thanks to the planned 40% expansion of coal production by 2030 and the good level of demand for Russian coal, there is also a rise in demand for mining equipment. Exports of German mining equipment went up 21.1% in 2018, reaching EUR 47.7 million. In view of this good environment, the Federal German Ministry for Economics decided to support German companies at UGOL ROSII & MINING 2019 with an official German pavilion.

By the closing date for German exhibitors in February, 26 companies had booked, including some newcomers,” says Peter Schmitz, Director of Messe Düsseldorf GmbH, who was clearly pleased.

In the Kemerovo region coal mining is to be increased from today's 241 million tonnes to up to 370 million tonnes. Modern mining and hoisting equipment is therefore just as much in demand as safety equipment and

Thematically focused conferences and a wide-ranging complementary programme of workshops, seminars and conferences will provide an ideal platform where industry representatives and specialists, both exhibitors and visitors, can exchange ideas.

The trade fair trio is organised by the Messe Düsseldorf Group, Messe Düsseldorf Moscow and their long-standing Russian partners, Kuzbass Fair. The specialist trade fairs UGOL ROSII & MINING, NEDRA ROSSII and SAFETY & HEALTH will be held at the exhibition centre in Novokuznetsk from 4 to 7 June 2019.
